July 19, 2016

The Des Moines County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at the Court House in Burlington at 9 AM on Tuesday, July 19th, 2016, with Tom Broeker, Bob Beck and Jim Cary present.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions passed unanimously.

Meet with Department Heads: Deputy Auditor Terri Johnson gave an update for the upcoming General Election. The candidate filing period will be August $8^{th} - 31^{st}$. Health Department Administrator Christa Poggemiller reported they have been awarded Pending Recognition to the criteria contained in the CDC Diabetes Prevention Recognition Program. Diabetes prevention needs to be addressed in the community. In their efforts to address diabetes prevention, a Public Health Nurse received lifestyle coach training. They applied for recognition to begin lifestyle coaching classes this fall. They will have Pending Recognition for one year and when the one year data is submitted they should be moved into Recognition status. Jail Administrator Doug Ervine reported they have fifty-two inmates at the jail. Conservation Office Manager Joel Behne reported Chris Lee is meeting with the AmeriCorp Group. They are working on trails and eradicating invasive species at Big Hollow. Joel plans to attend the funeral of former Sheriff Merritt Quick. County Engineer Brian Carter reported on several projects. The Madison Ave project may be on hold. A utility failed to realize a gas line was within the project scope. Skunk River Rd culvert replacement project started yesterday and should be done by tomorrow. North Gear and Flint Bottom Rd intersection paving should be done by the end of August. Asphalt work on the Mediapolis Rd has been moved to night work due to the extreme heat expected. Paving will start at 6PM. The Hwy 99 paving is continuing.

Correspondence: Received a letter from the Henry County Supervisors. The letter referenced the Patient Advocate 28E Agreement executed in December 2012. They wish to terminate their participation in the Agreement and the letter serves as their ninety day written notice to withdraw from the 28E Agreement. All county participants (including Des Moines, Lee and Louisa) will send letters to each county requesting the same termination. The Patient Advocate is now a regional Mental Health Advocate.

Accounts Payable Claims in the amount of \$958,900.19 were approved upon motion made by Cary. Seconded by Beck.

The Board presented a resolution adopting the Des Moines County Courthouse and Public Building Security Plan. Beck motioned to approve the resolution. Seconded by Cary.

RESOLUTION ADOPTING DES MOINES COUNTY COURTHOUSE AND PUBLIC BUILDINGS SECURITY PLAN

WHEREAS, Des Moines County, Iowa created a committee to establish a security and safety plan for the Des Moines County Courthouse and County public buildings, and

WHEREAS, said committee drafted a Des Moines County Courthouse and Public Buildings Security Plan, and

WHEREAS, such Plan is critical to ensure a safe working environment for County and State employees, and also for the safety of citizens who go to the Courthouse and/or other County public buildings, and

WHEREAS, the Plan includes actions to be taken in the case of natural disasters and for emergency procedures and the safe evacuation of the Courthouse and public buildings in case of threats of injury or violence, as well as to designate the roles and responsibilities of various individuals to assure that these policies is carried out.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Des Moines County Courthouse and Public Buildings Security Plan described above is hereby adopted and approved July 19, 2016 by the Des Moines County Board of Supervisors.

The initial training will be a forty-five minute video for employees regarding email phishing. Individual sessions will follow later. The second project is E-Forms for Department Heads and Employees to use. This will be a paperless program for timesheets and other documents.
