Neighbor Barry Denny said he was concerned about the number of lots and whether there would be more neighbors. Mr. Hanan explained that the originally platted residential lots are being consumed by Lot 12. He further explained that in order for the owner/developer to have any additional lots in the future they would have to go through another replatting.
