Meeting with Department Heads: Public Health Director Christa Poggemiller reported her office is busy. County Attorney Lisa Schaefer stated her office is busy. Maintenance Director Rodney Bliesener reported his staff continues to prepare for the winter months. Emergency Management Assistant Shannon Prado wants to remind everyone that the winter months are ahead of us and to be mindful of the weather.
