Unless otherwise noted, all motions passed unanimously.

Meet with Department Heads: the County Auditor announced that residents of the City of Burlington were voting today to extend the local option sales tax. Polling sites will be open until 8 PM. County Engineer Brian Carter reported that road maintenance projects are continuing. Broeker congratulated Conservation Director Kim Perlstein on the opening of the RV Park at Big Hollow. Land Use Administrator Jeff Hanan reported that the Planning and Zoning Commission had met to discuss the prohibition of tall structures in the airport zoning ordinance among other topics. An amendment will be coming to the Board for approval.

Correspondence received and filed: letter from Greater Burlington Partnership regarding the economic development agreement with General Electric. The employment level as of March 31, 2012 was 244 employees and wages are at 140% level of the county average.

Accounts Payable Claims in the amount of \$353,652.06 were approved upon motion by Beck. Cahill seconded.

Land Use Administrator Jeff Hanan presented the Resolution and Final Plat for Hallmark Subdivision. He explained that this was a one-lot subdivision in Franklin Township. Cahill moved to approve the subdivision. Seconded by Beck.
