It was determined that the Partners Board wished to have a wall as originally promised to donors during fundraising. However, they did agree that the final decision lies with the Conservation Board.

Eric Marshall and Paul Ziglar were both in attendance to give their professional thoughts to a future plan for the layout and/or wall and kiosk. There was much discussion. Director Lee will put together a listing of all donors needing to be recognized as well as to present a potential plan for a work session to be announced. This item will be placed back on the agenda for September.

12. Informational Items/Correspondence:

a. City/County Mountain Bike Trail Project.

Alex Buhmeyer, DMCC Operations Supervisor and bike enthusiast was present to outline a proposal to the Board regarding a City/County Mountain Bike Trail. This would potentially be on both City of Burlington and Des Moines County Property. No funding from either entity is anticipated. The area is located off of Golf Course Road and combines both the Leopold Recreation Area and property that is owned by the City across the road from Flint Hills Golf Course.

Alex has recently met with City Planner Eric Tysland and Director Lee as well as some of the members from local bike clubs. All seem very interested and excited about the prospect. The original trail would be less aggressive than a later trail in the same area. This would be in the interest of allowing many more less athletic individuals to utilize the trail.

Alex is working on building a coalition of 40 to 50 volunteers to initiate the trail and bridges as needed. This area does have some very tough terrain. Later funding would be based on grants that might be applied for. Planning will continue as the Board was amiable to the project with the understanding that this would not put additional responsibilities and workload on an already understaffed organization.

Alex thanked the board for the interest and advised that he would return with more information as the project proceeds.
