October 18th, 2016

The Des Moines County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at the Court House in Burlington at 9 AM on Tuesday, October 18th, 2016, with Tom Broeker, Bob Beck and Jim Cary present.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions passed unanimously.

Meet with Department Heads: the County Auditor reported that her office has received over 5,800 absentee ballot requests. Emergency Management Director Gina Hardin reported that FEMA Public Assistance was in town looking at flood damage. The County and City met the minimum of \$146,000 in damage from torrential rain storms several weeks ago. An application will be sent to the Governor to have the County be part of a public assistance benefit. County Engineer Brian Carter reported that crews are finishing up projects; there are some details and paperwork to complete. The contractor is almost done patching Bridgeport Road. His department is also stockpiling salt, preparing for winter driving. Conservation Director Chris Lee reported that his department will hold open interviews next Thursday at the Nature Center for day hire crews. Lee is also looking for a Naturalist Technician and Administrative Assistant. CDS Ken Hyndman reported that he will be getting an update from the crisis house this week. City/County Safety Director Angie Vaughan reminded that there will be a fire drill on October 26th.

Under correspondence, the US Environmental Protection Agency sent notice of a Class 1 modification of the closure plan for Igloos H-5 and H-14. This letter is on file in the County Auditor's office.

Accounts Payable Claims in the amount of \$912,218.36 were approved upon motion by Beck and second by Cary. Broeker stated that \$529,776.27 of that amount was paid on the loan to cover insurance premiums.

The reimbursement of Taxable Payroll Claims was also approved. Broeker explained that a change in IRS rules stipulate that reimbursements to an employee must be taxed as extra income; therefore as of July 1st those claims are paid through payroll instead of accounts payable. Cary moved to approve payment. Beck seconded.

Jeff Hanan presented the Resolution and Final Plat for Bell Housing Subdivision. Hanan stated that this is a one lot minor subdivision owned by Jim Bell and located on Roosevelt St. in Danville Township. The Zoning Board approved this subdivision unanimously. Hanan recommended approval. Beck moved to approve. Seconded by Cary.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS Section 354.8 of the Code of Iowa states that a governing body shall certify by resolution the approval of a subdivision plat, and,

WHEREAS the Final Plat for **Bell Housing Subdivision** has been reviewed for conformance to applicable County standards by the Des Moines County Health Department, Secondary Roads Department, County Auditor, Zoning Commission Chair and Land Use Department and has been duly recommended by the aforementioned entities for approval,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Final Plat of **Bell Housing Subdivision**.

Cary moved to approve minutes for the Board meeting held on October 11th, 2016. Seconded by Beck.

During other business, Cary reported that several people have contacted him about serving on a committee if an Administrative Code is written to control dangerous dogs. Broeker reported that he has read the information about the minimum wage issue that Sandy Dockendorff provided and still thinks that the minimum wage should be determined by the State Legislature. The county does not have the ability to enforce an Ordinance related to wages paid by a business within the county.

Future agenda items: a work session with the Conservation Director and Conservation Board.

Committee reports: Beck spoke at a DOT meeting at Dubuque last Tuesday and attended the Regional Planning annual lunch. Cary attended a RUSS meeting, where it was decided to pass on the Moar-Powdertown project. He also attended a South Iowa Area Juvenile Detention Agency meeting. Costs for housing have gone down considerably. Broeker attended meetings of the SEIL Governance Board and Grow Greater Burlington.

Meeting was adjourned at 9:53 AM.
