## December 17th, 2019

The Des Moines County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at the Court House in Burlington at 9 AM on Tuesday, December 17<sup>th</sup>, 2019, with Chairman Tom Broeker, Vice-Chair Bob Beck and Member Jim Cary present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted. Unless otherwise noted, all motions passed unanimously.

Meet with Department Heads: County Treasurer Janelle Nalley-Londquist reported her office is busy and stated beginning January 1st, 2020 all vehicle title transfers between private parties will require a bill of sale. A notice has been posted at the front entry of the courthouse and on the county website. Safety Director Angie Vaughan reported she is busy and reminded everyone it is snowy and slick outside after the snow fall received. She warned everyone to be careful, walk carefully and drive carefully. Sheriff Mike Johnstone agreed with Vaughan and her statement. Jail Administrator Doug Ervine reported the jail population is 103. CDS Director Ken Hyndman attended a change agent group meeting last week. He commented on an early childhood system two-hour presentation for the people involved in early childhood services. County Attorney Lisa Schaefer reported her office is busy. They have two District Court trials in January and a homicide trial also begins in January. County Engineer Brian Carter thanked the road crews. They were out early on Monday morning after the snow fall received early Sunday evening. Ditching projects were completed last week. Carter met with the Two Rivers Levee District this morning and the bid results for the two bridge projects on Mediapolis Road will be opened today. Assistant Land Use Administrator Jarred Lassiter reported Zach James and Lassiter met with County Departments to discuss subdivision review and ordinance updates. Broeker thanked the Maintenance Department for their snow clearing efforts around the courthouse. Others present were: Maintenance Supervisor Rodney Bliesener, Public Health Administrator Christa Poggemiller, IT Director Colin Gerst and Conservation Director Chris Lee.

Correspondence. Dan Cahill, Compensation Board member presented the Compensation Board's FY21 salary increase recommendations for elected officials. The Compensation Board recommended a 3% increase across the board for all elected officials. The Supervisors thanked Cahill and the Compensation Board.

Accounts Payable Claims in the amount of \$797,738.43 was presented. Cary motioned to approve and seconded by Beck.

Payroll Reimbursement Claims in the amount of \$1,420.42 and Non-Cash taxable in the amount of \$75.00 was presented. Cary motioned to approve and seconded by Beck.

Appointment to the Conservation Board was presented and discussed. A letter of interest was received from Conservation Board member Cathy Ziglar. After review of her terms, it was determined she has served a partial term and one full term. Therefore, she is still eligible for reappointment to another full term. The Board of Supervisors would like to keep the Conservation Board gender balanced. They thanked Daniel Fell for his application and hopes he is still interested when the next board position opens. Beck motioned to approve Cathy Ziglar to another term on the Conservation Board and seconded by Cary.
