The Des Moines County Board of Supervisors met in Special session at the Court House in Burlington at 9 AM on Wednesday, November 25th, 2020 with Chairman Tom Broeker, Vice-Chair Jim Cary and Member Bob Beck present. This meeting was held with limited capacity due to COVID-19 and electronically via Webex and YouTube live streaming. Public input was available through board email or call in.

The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.

Correspondence. Chairman Broeker read into record a letter from Greater Burlington Partnership addressing the rise in COVID-19 cases in the area and concerns of overwhelming local hospitals, their employees and a shortage of staff. The letter will be read at the Board's regular meeting on December 1st.

Canvass of the 2020 General Election Recount for US Representative District 2 was presented. The recount board met over the weekend on November 21st and November 22nd. The recount board chose to hand count the election day precinct ballots and machine count the absentee ballots. The final ballot count resulted in Mariannette Miller-Meeks receiving two more votes for a total of 9,641 and Rita Hart receiving three more votes for a total of 9,268. Cary motioned to approve and seconded by Beck. The new certified results will be sent to the Secretary of State's office for state certification on November 30th.

Meeting was adjourned at 9:20 AM.
