The Des Moines County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at the Court House in Burlington at 9 AM on Tuesday, December 15th, 2020 with Chairman Tom Broeker, Vice-Chair Jim Cary and Member Bob Beck present. This meeting was held with limited capacity due to COVID-19 and electronically via Webex and YouTube live streaming. Public input was available through board email or call in.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions passed unanimously. The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.

Meet with Department Heads: County Auditor Terri Johnson reported her office is busy and the payroll deputy position has been posted on the county website and applications will be accepted until December 30th. IT Director Colin Gerst stated his office is busy. County Engineer Brian Carter reported the contractor for the Hwy 99 bridge over Flint Creek is pouring concrete for the footing of the first pier. Next Wednesday the Dry Branch Creek Bridge will be closed to one lane to take soil borings. Carter thanked Bob Saar for the article on Flint Creek Bridge project. He stated it is good for the public to see how the process works and see the big picture of the construction situation. Carter reported the Flint Bottom Road project bid opening will be held at 11am today. Road crews are still ditching. Maintenance Supervisor Rodney Bliesener was present. Sheriff-Elect Kevin Glendening stated the Sheriff's Office has opened the application process for a deputy until December 30<sup>th</sup>. Promotions will take place within the office. The jail population is 77. County Attorney Lisa Schaefer reported they continue to work even though trials are on hold. A coronavirus grant for courtroom audio was approved for the full amount. They will be adding more visual options to assist in social distancing. More video screens, microphones, etc will be added. Local Health Administrator Christa Poggemiller reported her department is busy with contact tracing and gave a COVID update. The county is down to 11% rolling 14-day average with 145 additional positive cases for a total of 3,273 cases. Quarantine procedures have changed. Anyone exposed to someone testing positive needs to quarantine only 10 days if they test negative between 5 to 7 days after exposure. Distribution of the COVID vaccine will follow CDC guidance. They are planning the vaccine distribution for health care providers first. Via WebEx: Safety Director Angie Vaughan was present. Conservation Director Chris Lee reported his crews are busy harvesting firewood. Assistant Land Use Administrator Jarred Lassiter had an agenda item and thanked bob Beck for his years of service to the county. County Treasurer Janelle Nalley-Londquist reported her office is busy.

Accounts Payable in the amount of \$989,402.02 was presented. Beck motioned to approve and seconded by Cary.

Magistrate Appointing Commission appointments. Russell Fry, Nancy Schulte and Tamarra Washington submitted letters to request re-appointment to a six-year term. Cary motioned to approve all three and seconded by Beck.

Resolution and Final Plat for Kwitcher Subdivision was presented. This is a one-lot subdivision containing 3.22 acres located in the SW1/4 of Section 10 in Danville Township on 200<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Owner is Alsace Lorraine Heinold Trust. Subdivider is Bret Russell Heinold, 1706 Market St., Burlington. Assistant Land Use Administrator Jarred Lassiter spoke about the subdivision and recommended approval. Beck motioned to approve and seconded by Cary.
