

The Des Moines County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at the Courthouse in Burlington at 9:00 AM on Tuesday, May 17th, 2022, with Chairman Jim Cary, Vice-Chair Shane McCampbell, and Member Tom Broeker present. This meeting was also held electronically via Webex and YouTube live streaming. Public input was available through board email or call in.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions passed unanimously. The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.

Meet with Department Heads: Deputy Auditor Sara Doty stated she remains busy. IT Director Colin Gerst stated the office is busy. Sheriff Kevin Glendening reported the population at the jail is 68. Maintenance Director Rodney Bliesener stated he has several projects in the works. Frank Millard poured concrete for a portion of the Courthouse front steps yesterday. They are hoping to have all the concrete poured by the end of the week. Land Use Administrator Jarred Lassiter reported he attended a Board of Adjustment meeting last night on Zoning for the Summer Street Animal Clinic. He remains busy in the office. Conservation Director Chris Lee reported Big Hollow still has a few Memorial Day camping sites available, but they are filling up quick. County Treasurer Janelle Nalley-Londquist stated her office is preparing the delinquent taxes publication notice for the newspapers. CDS Director Ken Hyndman reported he will attend a SEIL meeting tomorrow. County Auditor Terri Johnson reported her office is busy preparing for the primary election. In-Person absentee voting will begin in the Auditor's Office on May 18th and end June 6th. If a voter sent in an absentee ballot request form to have a ballot mailed, the ballot will be mailed on May 18th. On Saturday June 4th the Auditor's Office will be open for absentee voting from 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. She reminded everyone to make sure to bring their photo ID when voting absentee at the Auditor's Office or voting at their polling location on election day. County Engineer Brian Carter stated projects are moving along. They hope to have Pleasant Grove Road open in 2-3 weeks, depending on weather. He is hoping the Geode Road project will open later this week. Mediapolis Road is now open. He stated the Tama Road Bridge Approach has settled and created a rough patch. He has contacted a contractor to come in and repair the bridge. Safety Director Angela Vaughan stated she remains busy in the office. County Recorder Natalie Steffener reported the first part of the digitizing project is complete. Public Health Administrator Christa Poggemiller reported her office is busy.

No correspondence was received.

Payroll Reimbursement Claims in the amount of \$1,146.37 were presented. Broeker made a motion to approve and seconded by McCampbell.
